### Sacrament of Baptism

Because of the importance of the celebration of the sacrament of baptism, please consider carefully the man or woman of faith you chose to inspire and educate your child in the ways of our faith for the entirety of their lives. We suggest calling the church office during your pregnancy so that a more thorough preparation may take place. Godparents must be practicing Catholics and submit a certificate of eligibility from their parish prior to the Baptism. Baptisms will normally take place at a parish weekend Mass. Date and time will be scheduled by the pastor.

For adequate preparation, arrangements should be made at least 6 months in advance.

### Sacrament of Anointing

Please let the parish office know if someone is seriously ill. If you know of anyone who is unable to get to Mass, we would be glad to help arrange transportation.

## TAKE NOTE

God has designed us such that we all have parental instincts; we all have a desire to be mothers or fathers. Not all of us become parents, yet we all will have the responsibility to care for or teach the next generation, to take on, to some extent, a motherly or fatherly role. May is a month traditionally dedicated to Mary, and by extension, to all mothers. Mary agreed to be mother, and in doing so, got more than she bargained for, as she has taken on a motherly role for all of us, children of the Church. In the terminology of the Church's most recently added feast, which will be celebrated the day after Pentecost, she is **Mater Ecclesia, "Mother of the Church"**. Make the effort this month, not only to honor your earthly mother and the other women who have filled that role in your life, but also to honor Mary, Mother of Jesus, Mother of God. A half an hour before every Mass here at St. Paul's, there is always a group of people praying the rosary together. Even if its not typically your style of prayer, make the effort at least once this month to show up half an hour before Mass to pray the rosary. Perhaps you could offer it in thanksgiving of or for the health and salvation of your own mother!
