Sacrament of Baptism

Because of the importance of the celebration of the sacrament of baptism, please consider carefully the man or woman of faith you chose to inspire and educate your child in the ways of our faith for the entirety of their lives. We suggest calling the church office during your pregnancy so that a more thorough preparation may take place. Godparents must be practicing Catholics and submit a certificate of eligibility from their parish prior to the Baptism. Baptisms will normally take place at a parish weekend Mass. Date and time will be scheduled by the pastor.

For adequate preparation, arrangements should be made at least 6 months in advance.

Please let the parish office know if someone is seriously ill. If you know of anyone who is unable to get to Mass, we would be glad to help arrange transportation.

TAKE NOTE

This Wednesday is the Feast day of St. Benedict (480-574), the founder of monasteries and the author of the Rule that directs the lives of many monasteries to this day. Some people perceive the lives of religious sisters and brothers in monasteries as people who have run away from the world, but on the contrary, those who take this sort of life seriously, and do the hard work of a monk, gain a greater understanding of their own humanity, the humanity of others, and of the power and love of God. This Wednesday, I invite everyone to try living as a monk for a day. The life of a monk is *ora et labora*, a balance of prayer and work, supplemented by times of recreation and rest. The prayer and work alternates throughout the day, and it's done with and for the family of the monastery. So this Wednesday, whatever work you have to do, remember that you are doing it with and for your family and your community, and take the time during the day to alternate that work with prayer. I will provide you with the booklet for the prayers of the day, and you can either join me at the church at the times listed, or do them on your own wherever you happen to be. The times of prayer are:

- (1) Invitatory - whenever you get up
- (2) Morning Prayer (Lauds) - in the morning, At the church it will be at the end of the 9:00 AM Mass
- (3) Midday Prayer (Sext) - Noon
- (4) Evening Prayer (Vespers) - 6:00 PM
- (5) Night Prayer (Compline) - 9:00 PM.

I promise, it won't be easy as it looks! If you want to sign up, give Fr. Dan a call or an e-mail, and pick up the booklet of prayers in the Church.
