**** Reminder to all parents regarding Sacramental Programs:**

First Communion – a child needs to be attending Mass regularly, be enrolled and attending religious education classes for 2 years before receiving First Communion (generally 1st & 2nd grade) and be 7 or more years of age.

Confirmation – a student needs to be attending mass regularly, be enrolled in the religious education program, completed the high school class component (all 3 cycles) and be at least 16 years of age.

Parents need to present the student’s baptismal certificate if baptized outside of St. Paul’s before reception of First Communion/Confirmation. All families should be registered members of St. Paul’s Parish.
