What is a Jubilee Year?

It is also known as a Holy Year. It's a year focused on renewing our call to holiness, strengthening our connection with God, focusing on forgiveness of sins, reconciliation, solidarity, hope, and service to others. Currently, they occur in the Catholic Church every 25 years.

When does the Jubilee Begin and End?

The Jubilee began on December 24, 2024, when Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of the Basilica of Saint Peter in the Vatican. The Ordinary Jubilee will conclude with the closing of the Holy Door in the Papal Basilica of Saint Peter in the Vatican on January 6, 2026, the Solemnity of the Feast of the Epiphany.

What is a Pilgrimage?

A pilgrimage is a fundamental element of every Jubilee event. In his Bull of Indiction SPES NON

CONFUNDIT, the Pope's official document regarding this Jubilee Year, Pope Francis says, "Setting out on a journey is traditionally associated with our human quest for meaning in life." Some may journey to Rome to see the Holy Sites there. If you cannot make that trip, there are Holy sites that can be pilgrimage destinations for you here in our diocese. The Pope says these Holy sites can serve as an oasis of spirituality, places of rest on the pilgrimage of faith, where we can drink from the wellspring of hope."
